

A River Crossing For Sunbury

Summary of full report

Cratus Communications has worked with the Lower Sunbury Residents' Association (LOSRA) to deliver a process of consultation relating to possible locations for a pedestrian and cycle crossing over the Thames.

Beginning in March 2015 and concluding in July 2015 this process of consultation has made use of a wide variety of consultation methods in order to canvass opinion and capture preferences between the five possible sites which have been identified as feasible.

Residents have been asked to express themselves to a standard framework to allow for expressions to be brought together and analysed. The question asked residents to indicate their preferences for the sites using 1-5, 1 indicating the greater support.

Site B, Flowerpot Green has considerable support in the local area with site C on Church Street enjoying the most second preference support.
